#### Prince of Peckham

Prince of Peckham first opened its doors in May 2017. Since then, it has become a local institution and is a cornerstone of the Peckham social scene.

Prince of Peckham is a three-floor building, with three bars and four spaces available for private hire.

The basement of the venue houses The Shrine, a brandnew speakeasy style bar. The ground floor is where the Main Bar and Yellow Room are located and the first floor has two spaces, The Music Room and The Blue Room, a private dining room.

The venue's capacity is over 330, split between the three floors. The whole venue is beautifully decorated and has a warm and inviting feel. Prince of Peckham's aim is to provide a home away from home.

Prince of Peckham has hosted a huge variety of events and shoots, from private parties, weddings, launches, activity classes to brand commercials, television dramas, documentaries, podcasts and music videos.

### COVID-19 Regulations






The Main Bar on the ground floor of the pub, is a horseshoe shaped bar with three bridge shaped beer fonts.

The Main Bar has a standing capacity of 110 and a seated capacity of 63. The room is 220m<sup>2</sup>.

The bar has been used to film TV programmes such as Sky's drama, Temple and BBC TWO's Saving Britain's Pub with Tom Kerridge as well as being used for numerous commercials, music videos and photo shoots.



# The Music Room







The Music Room is on the first floor of the pub. It's a large open space, with a bar and built in DJ booth.

The Music Room has a standing capacity of 80/90 and a seated capacity of 32. It is  $120m^2$ .

The Music Room has been used as a location for fashion shoots, video podcasts and music videos, as well as a space for business meetings, exercise classes and weddings.






# The Shrine







The Shrine is our brand-new basement bar. Named after his venue in Lagos, Nigeria, The Shrine is a homage to the celebrated musician Fela Kuti. It has a bar, DJ booth and dancefloor/seating area.


The Shrine has a capacity of 30 standing and 21 seated. It is 120m<sup>2</sup>.

The Shrine has been used for video podcasts, fashion shoots and interviews. It is also available for private hire.








The Yellow Room is available for private hire and has been featured in television dramas as well as music videos.











## The Blue Room








The Blue Room is Prince of Peckham's private dining room, adjacent to the Music Room on the first floor.

The Blue Room has been used for photo shoots, video podcasts and interviews and often acts as a green room whilst shoots are taking place.






## Catering and Drinks

Our resident chefs White Men Can't Jerk are available for all your catering needs. They can provide a custom menu for your crew. A typical full day of catering is listed below, menu options and prices may vary depending on your requirements.

Breakfast - From £10 per head.

Pastries, bacon or sausage baps (vegetarian options available), overnight oats (vegan), fresh fruit and yoghurt.

Lunch or dinner - From £12 per head.

Jerk Chicken/Jerk Halloumi/Jerk Cauliflower with rice and peas, coleslaw, jerk barbeque sauce and pineapple scotch bonnet jam.

Snacks - Honey glazed chicken wings, cauliflower poppers, jerk fries.

Drinks - From £15 per head.

Tea, coffee and soft drinks for the day.

Please let us know if you would like to purchase any alcohol and we'd be happy to accommodate. We can offer a range or wines, beers, spirits and cocktails.





#### Hire Policy

All personnel and equipment must be out of the building by the agreed exit time. If you require further time, this may be possible. There will be an additional fee for this.

You may store equipment in the venue overnight, however Prince of Peckham is not responsible for loss or damage of any of anything left on the premises.

We are a functional and operational business meaning that we may require areas of the venue back by a certain time, this is non-negotiable.

All payments <u>must</u> be made no later than 48 hours in advance of the day of rental.

The building must be left in the condition it was when you arrived at the end of your hire. Any furniture moved or equipment or fixtures removed or put up must be replaced the way you found them. Failure to do so will result in you being charged a damages fee.

#### **FAQs**

#### Is there parking at the pub?

There are no allocated parking spaces outside the pub, but you are welcome to load and unload equipment via our back gate.

There are plenty of roads nearby with free parking, notably Meeting House Lane or Stafford Street.

Morrison's supermarket nearby has free parking for 2 hours if temporary parking is needed.

## What time am I able to gain access to the pub in the morning?

We are flexible on start times and we are available to let crews into the building as early as 6am.

#### How much electrical power do you have?

We run on a three-phase system which is relatively robust, however if you plan on using excessive amounts of power, we recommend you bring your own power source.

#### Are we able to move furniture?

Yes, you can move any furniture or bring your own props or furniture if necessary. The furniture and rooms must be moved back to their original state one you have finished.
